
BIRDHOUSE CUTTING DIAGRAM BY JENNIFERMAKER



1¹/2-in hole, centered

6-in

 3 /4-in x 5 1 /2-in x 72-in pine board

- 1. Cut pieces according to diagram.
- 2. Glue base halves together and bracket.
- 3. Glue and nail front, back, and sides together.
- 4. Glue and nail bottom of house to base.
- 5. Glue and nail two pieces of roof together, then attach bracket to inside peak of roof.
- 6. Place the roof on the house where you want it to go, mark the overhangs, then glue and nail bracket inside roof peak based on how much overhang you want in the front and the back.
- 9. Decorate the exterior and seal for weather resistance. Do not paint or seal the inside.

Creates a house with an inside dimension of 4" x 5.5" and an interior height of 9", which is suitable for chickadees, house sparrows, nuthatches, downy woodpeckers, and wrens.
