

## FAQs for Small Paper Flowers



***Q: What kind of paper should I use?***

**A:** Use high quality cardstock for best results. I've used 176gram/65lb weighted. You can find a variety of colors and textures at most craft stores. I use Hobby Lobby & Michaels craft store. And here is one online source I love to use. [Cardsandpockets.com](http://Cardsandpockets.com)

***Q: What other supplies will I need?***

**A:** Sharp craft scissors (this is important, dull scissors will not make clean cut edges)

- Glue gun & sticks

- Patience, everybody makes mistakes and needs time to learn a little. If your first flower doesn't turn out perfect just try again!

***Q: How can I stem my small paper flowers?***


***Q: What if I don't have a cutting machine?***

**A:** For small bouquet flowers cutting machines are recommended, although I do provide an outline of the petals if you wish to print and hand cut the small flowers. Of course this process takes longer and a lot of patience. But if you are ambitious, then go for it!

An outline PDF option is included if you wish to run cardstock through your printer and cut out following a printed line.

***Q: How do I lay out my petals with my cutting machine?***

**A:** The overall goal is for the upload to be within an 8.5 x 11 margin to be the same size I am using. If yours loads larger you can just downsize accordingly or look in the Youtube video's description of that specific flower's tutorial to see petal measurements.



***Q: What if I want my flowers to be bigger?***

**A:** If you have a cutting machine you can of course just enlarge the petals as you wish. If you are hand cutting I recommend sending the PDFs to your local printer and having them enlarged.

***Q: Can I sell the flowers I make with these templates?***

**A:** Selling the flower designs is allowed only under a Seller's license agreement.
