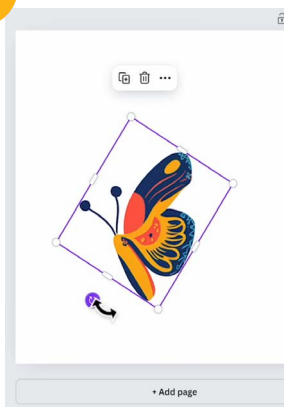


# HOW TO CREATE SEAMLESS PATTERNS

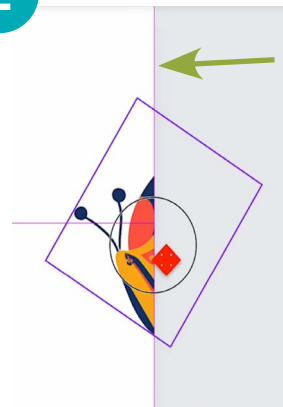

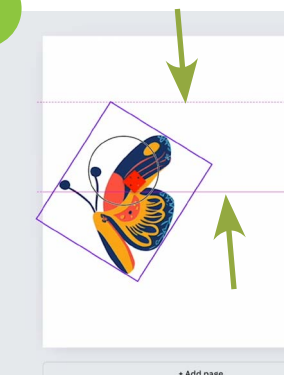
Go to [canva.com](https://canva.com) — you can use a Free or Pro account." Create your canvas in your desired size. Choose an element from the Elements icon and add it to your canvas. Resize and rotate the element as desired.

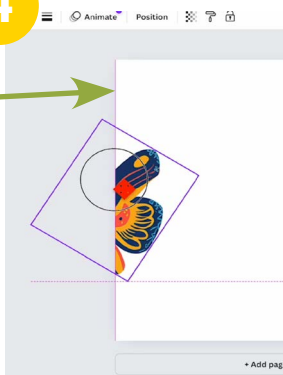
Move the element off the edge of the canvas until a thin pink line appears at the edge of the canvas, which means the element is divided in half. You can do this at either side, the top, or the bottom edge of the canvas. Duplicate the element.

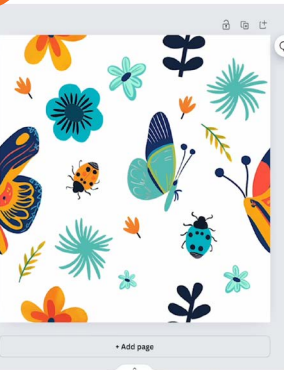
Carefully move the duplicate across from the original element. Make sure a pink line is in the center of the element and a pink line is at the top or bottom of the element so that it stays even with the original element.

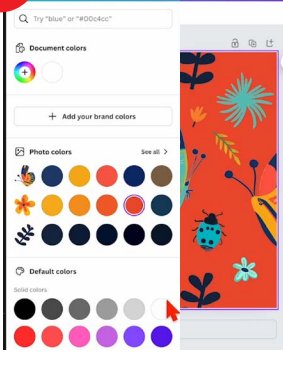
Stop moving the duplicate element once a pink line appears along the edge of the canvas. This means that the element is divided in half and the two element halves will come together seamlessly.

Add more elements to the canvas, some at the edges and some entirely on the canvas. Resize and rotate the elements as desired. Remember to look for the pink lines when working at the edges of the canvas.

To add a background color, click on white space in the canvas, click the rainbow circle in the top menu, and choose a color. When finished, click "Share" and download your pattern as a PNG.

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
